However, the participants in this year's run were pleasantly surprised to find partly cloudy skies and temperatures in the 40's and 50's on the one mile loop course. The fair weather brought out a good turnout of ultrarunners and a few ultrawalkers with a higher percentage than usual staying on the course for longer periods of time.
